ADMISSION POLICY FOR 2 YEARS'
D.El.Ed. DIPLOMA COURSE
(Session 2025-27)

Admission to two years' Diploma in Elementary Education (D.El.Ed.) course in government and private affiliated institutions as per National Council for Teachers Education (Recognition Norms and Procedure) Regulations 2014 through combined entrance test and combined merit, based on the result of the entrance test is to be undertaken by State Council of Educational Research and Training (SCERT), Vidya Bhawan, School Education Board, Block-E, 6th Floor, SAS Nagar-160062.

ACADEMIC SESSION

The academic session 2025-27 will commence from July 2025

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

MINIMUM EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATION

- A . Candidates should have passed graduation with minimum 50% marks in case of general category and 45% marks in the case of scheduled castes / backward classes and physically handicapped candidates from a recognized institution.
- B . Candidates must have passed Punjabi up to matric level/ standard.
- C . To ensure high quality standards, candidate must have passed in the subjects- English, Hindi, Punjabi, Science, Social studies and Mathematics in class X examination.

AGE LIMIT

Maximum age limit as on date of application for admission to the course for general category candidate will be 37 years' (Government of Punjab Notification Department of personnel No.G.S.R.20/Const./Art.309/Amd.(10)/2010 dated 24/05/2010), Five years' of relaxation to SC/ST candidates and 10 years' of relaxation for physically handicapped candidates.

RESIDENTIAL STATUS

The candidate must be resident of Punjab state.

DURATION

- A. The D.El.Ed. Programme shall be of duration of two academic years; however, the students shall be permitted to complete the programme within a maximum period of three years from the date of admission of the programme.

- B. Only passed candidate in D.El.Ed Ist year can proceed D.El.Ed second year.
- C. If first year is not cleared or candidate did not appear in first year exam what so ever the circumstances, the candidate will not be allowed to get admission in D.El.Ed second year. However, candidate having reappear in one, two or three subjects shall be promoted to second year.

WORKING DAYS

- A. There shall be at least two hundred working days each year, exclusive of the period of examination and admission process.
- B. Institutions shall work for a minimum of 36 hours in a week, during which physical presence of all the teachers and student teachers is necessary in the institution to ensure the availability for advice, guidance, dialogue and consultation as and when needed.
- C. The minimum attendance of student teacher shall be 80% for all course work including practicum and 90% for school internship.
- D. The course shall have 4 weeks and 16 weeks of school internship in the first and second year respectively. School internship will be in same district where parent institute is situated.

SELECTION CRITERIA

Selection of the candidates will be done on the basis of merit in the entrance test. The minimum marks to qualify this entrance test will be 50% in aggregate and 5% relaxation to qualify entrance test will be given to the reserve categories (scheduled castes/ backward classes and physically handicapped) as per the guidelines of the government of Punjab. The entrance test will be conducted by SCERT Punjab. The date of entrance test, syllabus and structure of the entrance test will be uploaded on the website of the department.

TIE

In case of a tie in merit of entrance test, preference will be given to candidate having higher marks in graduation. In case of further tie of such candidates, preference will be given to candidate having higher marks in 10+2 and if again tie preference will be given to candidate who will be older in age.

ONLINE APPLICATION & PROCESSING FEE

Rs. 1350/- (Including GST) for General Category/ BC/ O.B.C./Freedom Fighter/Sports/EWS etc.

Rs. 750/- (Including GST) for SC/ ST / Physically Handicapped Category

No Fee for Ex- Serviceman (Self)

COUNSELING, SCRUTINY AND VERIFICATION

Online counselling will be held for admission for the academic session 2025-27. Director, SCERT, Punjab shall supervise the whole counselling/admission process. For every district a committee shall be formed under the principal of concerned DIET, consisting of lecturer of that DIET and District MIS Co-ordinator. This committee will ensure smooth completion of counselling process and shall scrutinize the documents of the candidates who are provisionally allotted their institute through online centralized counselling.

FILLING OF D.El.Ed. SEATS IN PRIVATE INSTITUTIONS

60% of seats in private institutions will be filled on the basis of combined merit of entrance test through centralized online counselling by the SCERT, remaining 40% of seats of management quota of private institutions will be filled based upon the following criteria.

1. The minimum marks to qualify this entrance test will be 50% in aggregate and 5% relaxation to qualify entrance test will be given to the reserve categories (scheduled castes/scheduled tribes / backward classes and physically handicapped).
2. Candidates should have passed Graduation with minimum 50% marks in case of general category and 45% marks in the case of Scheduled Castes/Backward Classes and Physically Handicapped candidates from a recognized institution.
3. The minimum marks to qualify this Entrance Test will be 50% in aggregate and 5% relaxation to qualify entrance test will be given to the reserve categories (scheduled castes/scheduled tribes / backward classes and physically handicapped).
4. Information regarding the filled seats of management quota will provide by the self-financed colleges to SCERT through online and offline mode within given time limit. No admission will be considered after the last date given by department.

In case above mentioned 60% of seats in private institutions are not filled in all centralized merit-based counselling conducted by SCERT, the vacant seats of the concerned private institute will be allowed to be filled up by the private institutions themselves as per merit of entrance examination and all other conditions framed for admission to D.El.Ed session 2025-27 course including reservation policy mentioned in notification.

FEES

The District Institute of Education and Training (DIETs) and Private Self-Financed D.El.Ed. institutions will charge fees as determined by the fee fixation committee and approved by the Department of School Education, Govt. of Punjab.

MIGRATION POLICY

For admission in D.El.Ed. course in Punjab, applications shall be sought online from candidates and the counselling shall also be done online. Seats will be allotted in various DIETs on the basis of merit in combined entrance test. A migration policy has been framed to rationalize this process: -

- This policy has been made keeping in view the need to implement the regular migration policy of the department to ensure opportunity to the trainees in Punjab DIETs to get educational facilities near their homes
- Under this policy, the trainees studying in self-financed (private) colleges affiliated with S.C.E.R.T will not be entitled to migration.
- Under this policy, only the trainees of first year in D.El.Ed. course will be eligible for migration. The trainees of second year in D.El.Ed. course will not be eligible for migration.
- This policy will apply on mutual and single migration cases.
- Single migration will be done purely on merit basis against the vacant seats in case the number of applications in a category are more, migration will be done according to the merit.
- Describing the available vacant seats in various DIETs, after the admission in the first year for the purpose of migration of the trainees, a public notice will be issued on the website of the department, in which details of category wise vacancies will be reported.
- The trainees who want to get migrated will apply online by 10th of November.
- Migration will be done according to the categories. That is if a general category seat is vacant in DIET, then only a general category trainee will be migrated to that seat. The same applies to other categories like SC category trainee is eligible for SC category seat, BC category trainee is eligible for BC category seat, ex-service man category trainee is eligible for ex-service man category seat, freedom fighter category trainee is eligible for freedom fighter category seat, handicapped category trainee is eligible for handicapped category seat.
- In mutual migration cases, both trainees will be migrated only after receiving written consent from the concerned heads of the institution. This will also be done category wise.
- The government holds the authority to give preference to the handicapped and trainees suffering from chronic diseases.
- Students with long absence will not be considered for migration.

NO MID-TERM FILLING OF SEATS

There shall be no mid-term filling up of seats caused due to any reason whatsoever.

FALSE DOCUMENTS

The admission of any candidate found to have obtained on the basis of false, forged, fabricated or tampered document shall be liable to be cancelled at any stage, besides registering a criminal case against him/her and barring him/her for re-admission in D.El.Ed for a period of three years.

In case of any dispute, the final decision will be taken by the Director SCERT.

ADMISSION IS NO GUARANTEE TO EMPLOYMENT

Admission to government or privately run D.El.Ed. Diploma Course or passing of the said course shall not confer any right to employment upon the recipient of such a diploma in the employment of the state or elsewhere.
